When is it? February 14, 2009 at 6:00 in the evening.

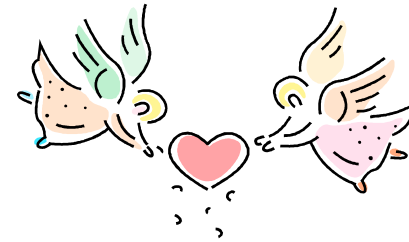
Where is it? The fellowship hall at Rockledge Presbyterian Church.
